

## Hair and Beauty Overviews

Term	Half Term	Year 10 Overview
Autumn	HT1 Consultation and Health and Safety	<p>Throughout this unit pupils will know how to follow all health and safety procedures for the smooth and safe running of a salon. Pupils will know how to be able to ensure clients and visitors are safe at all times and know how to assist them with the correct safety procedures. Pupils will be able to carry out risk assessments and be able to identify the difference between hazards and risks. Pupils will also know how to report and deal with any workplace accidents effectively.</p> <p>Pupils will also know how to conduct a thorough consultation, with the use of a consultation record, by using open and closed questioning techniques and by knowing how to examine the hair structure, hair type, hair condition, hair length, hair classifications and hair density so that they know colours, products and styles which can and cannot be completed on their clients hair. Pupils will also know how to identify infections and infestations and how these can be effectively dealt with.</p>
	HT2 Shampoo and Treat the Hair	<p>Throughout this unit pupils will know how to shampoo and treat the hair. Pupils will know about a variety of products that are used during the service and how, when and why to use different massage techniques. Pupils will know how to identify the condition of a client's hair, which will help them decide which products and massage techniques to use. Pupils will know how to avoid tangling the hair when shampooing and treating the hair, how to give clients advice on products to use at home and how to massage and comb their own hair correctly.</p>
Spring	HT3 Blow Dry and Finish Hair	<p>Throughout this unit pupils will know how to blow- dry and finish hair below shoulder length hair, create root lift and curl the ends under. Pupils will know how to choose which products, tools and equipment to use to complete the look. Pupils will know how to use straighteners to finish the service and how and why to provide their client with good aftercare advice on how to maintain the style at home or recreate it.</p>
	HT4 Manicure	<p>Throughout this unit pupils will know how to perform a basic manicure treatment. Pupils will know about a variety of products used during the treatment, as well as how to use tools to do cuticle work to improve the appearance of the nails. Pupils will know how to identify the condition of their client's skin and nails, which will help them to decide which products and tools to use. Pupils will know how to massage their client's hands and lower arm using effleurage and petrissage techniques. Pupils will also know how to apply nail polish using precision techniques to achieve a professional finish.</p>

Summer	HT5 Plait and Twist Hair	Throughout this unit pupils will know how to create a look using twists and a fishtail plait by using neat even sections and an even tension throughout. Pupils will know how to work hygienically and safely, identifying any problems that may affect or prevent the service being carried out. Pupils will know how to use products to complete the look, give clients aftercare advice for the maintenance of the twist and plait and how to remove it.
	HT 6 Formative Assessment	Throughout this half term pupils will show how they know how to incorporate all of the skills and knowledge which they have previously been taught into the completion of formative assessments. Pupils will know how to complete assessment plans to demonstrate the skills which they are formatively being assessed on, evaluate these skills and also receive individual feedback to support their progression over the next academic year and achieve summative assessments to ensure they gain their Hair and Beauty Qualification.

Term	Half Term	Year 11 Overview
Autumn	HT1 Create and Image Based on a Theme	Throughout this unit, which will be completed throughout the Autumn term, pupils will create a total look including hair, make-up and nails based on a theme. Pupils will know how to research themes for their idea and create an action plan and mood board detailing all their ideas for the total look.
	HT2 Create and Image Based on a Theme	Throughout this unit, which is continued from the previous half term, pupils will create a total look including hair, make-up and nails based on a theme. Pupils will have an understanding of why creating a mood board is important for developing their final look and will also be able to evaluate their finished image. The final image will be demonstrated within a hair show which all pupils will participate in.

Spring	HT3 and HT4 Summative Assessment	Throughout this term pupils will show how they know how to incorporate all of the skills and knowledge which they have previously been taught into the completion of summative assessments. Pupils will know how to complete assessment plans to demonstrate the skills which they are summatively being assessed on, evaluate these skills and also receive individual feedback to support their progression to ensure they gain their Hair and Beauty Qualification.
